

In reference to the Subway Under the Frisco Right of way running north, ^{and} The Corporation Commission having ordered the above Subway Constructed, It was Requested by Mr. Mitchell that the County Commissioners take some up by Correspondence ^{and} try to get the Rail way Company to Construct the same.

A resolution was adopted by the Board of County Commissioners in the following form -

Ordered by Unanimous vote of the Board of County Commissioners in Regular Session assembled.

It was agreed by the Board of County Commissioners that a proposition be submitted to the ^{of} the Baird Bridge Company with reference to buying the Bridge across Bird Creek. As the Commissioners wished to make a price upon the Bridge - It was agreed that the three (3) bids be added together ^{and} divided by '3' three, in order to arrive at the price to be submitted. - After making their bids ^{and} finding the amount, The following resolution was made.

Moved ^{and} Seconded that the Baird Bridge Company be made an offer of \$417.²⁵ for the Toll Bridge across Bird Creek. Carried.

Moved ^{and} Seconded to authorize the City of Tulsa to place (2) two lights on the County Bridge across the Arkansas River between Tulsa ^{and} W. Tulsa - Carried.
