Moldboard and 2 ft. extentions at a rental of \$275.00 per month, the period commencing on the 1st day of Dec., and terminating on the 31st day of Dec, be renewed for a period of thirty (30) days commencing on the 1st day of Jan and terminating on the 31st day of Jan, which Lease Contract has heretofore been entered into between the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, and THE CLARENCE L.
