

MONDAY, APRIL 20th, 1942.

The Board of County Commissioners met in regular session on Monday, April 20th, 1942, at the hour of 10:00 o'clock A .M., with all members present: J. B. Gray, Chairman; Ralsa F. Morley and Curtis Greer, members. Andy Stokes, County Clerk.

J. B. Gray, Chairman presiding, the following business was transacted.

This being the day set for the opening of bids on the furnishing of materials and performing the work necessary to be done for the paving and otherwise improving of Memorial Boulevard from Admiral Place southwardly to East Eleventh Street, a distance of 0.89 mile. The bids were as follows:
