In the matter of the installation of Electric Pole Line along certain Highways by the Oklahoma Power and Water Co. the following order was made:

O R D E R

NOW, On this 21st. day of December, 1931, comes on for hearing the application of the Oklahoma Power and Water Co., for permission to install an electric pole line as per plat attached to its application, marked Exhibit "A", and made a part thereof, said electric pole line beginning near the southwest corner of Section 35, Township 20 North, Range 11, East, thence East for a distance of approximately 3000 feet parallel to and near the North right of way line of the County line road.

And, it appearing to the Board, and each of the Commissioners thereof, that it is just and necessary that said application be granted, and it further appearing that said electric pole line will not interfere with any of the rights of the general public in the use of said highway, and that such electric pole line will be constructed in accordance with all lawful rules of the County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, and all laws of the State of Oklahoma, governing same.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND ADJUDGED by the Board of County Commissioners of said Tulsa County, Oklahoma, that such application be granted, and it is hereby granted to the Oklahoma Power and Water Co., and its assigns, to use as much of the highway as above designated for the purpose of constructing said electric pole line.

The following Resolution was introduced by Mr.Bohnfeld, who moved its adoption and the motion to adopt was seconded by Mr.North, and the Chairman ordered the resolution read:

WHEREAS, for the purpose of constructing a highway through and across a certain parcel of land in Section Twenty Seven (27), Township Nineteen (19), North, Range Twelve (12) East, Tulsa County Oklahoma, it is necessary to acquire an Easement across said parcel of land more particularly described as follows:

"A strip of land five (5') feet wide for additional right of way for highway purposes along the South Side of Lot Fourteen (14) Block Thirteen (13) in Carbondale in Section 27, T 19 N., R 12 E., Tulsa County Oklahoma, containing 0.016 acre".

AND, WHEREAS, Tulsa County has been unable to affect an amicable settlement in the matter of the said parcel of land owned by A E SNODGRASS.

AND, WHEREAS, it is necessary to acquire an EASEMENT across said parcel of land for right of way for highway purposes by condemnation proceedings.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the County Attorney, in the name of this Board, for an on behalf thereof, be and he is hereby instructed to institute condemnation proceedings in the District Court of this County for the purpose of condemning said above described parcel of land for right of way for highway purposes.

The vote on the motion to adopt the resolution was unanimously carried and Resolution adopted.
