

## Commissioners Proceedings

June 5-6-7-1911

Regular meeting June 5<sup>th</sup> 1911. Board met in regular session at the office of the County Clerk all members being present.

The following bills were audited and allowed.

Bond of Dr. Demberger for constructing water system for new Court was accepted and his Certified Check ordered returned to him.

Motion made by Mr. North that three hundred dollars be appropriated out of the contingent fund to aid the County Fair Association of Tulsa County. Seconded by Mr. Woolley. Motion Carried. Moved by Mr. North and Seconded by Mr. Woolley that the Clerk be instructed to look up matter of Justice of the Peace Dockets and Status held by former Justices. Motion Carried.

Moved by Mr. North that the five hundred dollars paid to the County Treasure some time ago together with draft for \$3023.83 be apportioned by County Treasure. Seconded by Mr. Woolley. Motion Carried.

Board of County Commissioners proceeded to act as County Board of Equalization and took up matter of assessments of various townships.

Tuesday June 6<sup>th</sup> 1911.

Board of County Commissioners met at usual hour all members being present, as County Board of Equalization.

The day was given to adjusting matter of assessments for the various townships.

Moved by Mr. North and Seconded by Mr. Woolley that the Board adjourn to Wednesday Morning. Carried.

Wednesday - June 7 - 1911.

Board met at regular hour all members present. Continued their work as Board of Equalization, — Equalizing, correcting and adjusting the assessors Rolls of the townships and towns of the County.

Motion Made by Mr. North Seconded by Mr. Woolley that the petition of the Wekiwa Township Board be accepted for proposed road as petition on file. Motion Carried.
