Motion made by Commissioner Hardesty, seconded by Commissioner Bailey and unanimously carried, that the appointment of Doyle G. Odgen as a Deputy Sheriff, effective September 9, 1949, to fill the vacancy created by the resignation of George D. Monroe, be and the same is hereby approved.

Motion made by Commissioner Hardesty, seconded by Commissioner Bailey, and unanimously arried, that the appointment of Ralph Gardiner as a Deputy Sheriff, effective September 8, 1949, to fill the vacancy left by A. H. Henshall, be and the same is hereby approved.

Motion made by Commissioner Hardesty, seconded by Commissioner Bailey, and unthat the animously carried, Memorandum of Agreement for Extension Work between Tulsa County and the Extension Division of the Oklahoma Agricultural and Mechanical College, be approved by the Board of County Commissioners as set-out in the Memorandum of Agreement for Extension Work.
