NOTICE OF SPECIAL ELECTION UPON THE QUESTION
OF WHETHER OR NOT A NEW COURT HOUSE AND JAIL SHALL BE
ERECTED BY TULSA COUNTY, AND BONDS IN THE AMOUNT OF
\$750,000.00 be issued and sold to pay therefor.

TO ALL QUALIFIED ELECTORS AND VOTERS OF TULSA COUNTY, OKLAHOMA:

Notice is hereby given that a special election has been called by the Board of County Commissioners for a special election to be held in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, on September 30, 1938, at which time the following proposition will be voted upon by the voters of Tulsa County, Oklahoma:

Shall Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, erect a new Court House and Jail and issue and sell bonds of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, in the amount of \$750,000.00 to pay for the erection thereof?

That the ballot used at said election shall set forth the proposition above set forth, and shall contain the following words:

— First, for the erection of a Court House and Jail and the issuing of bonds to pay therefor.

— Second. against the erecting of a Court House and Jail and the issuing of bonds to pay therefor.

(If the voter desires to vote for the above proposition he shall stamp X in the first —. If the voter desires to vote against the proposition he shall stamp X in the second —.)

Said election is to be conducted at the regular precinct voting places as selected by the Election Board of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, that the polls will be open in the forenoon at 8 o'clock, and shall be kept open continuously until the hour of 6 o'clock in the afternoon, except in cities of first class and all precincts surrounding, bounding or adjoining said cities of first class the polls shall be open at 6 o'clock in the forenoon and kept open continuously until the hour of 7 o'clock in the afternoon.
