Motion by Commissioner Morley, seconded by Commissioner Gray, that the report filed by Cal Crum, Court Clerk, for the month of March, 1942, be and the same is hereby accepted and filed. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Wm. Stansbury, Superintendent of the County Farm, deposited on April 23rd, 1942, with the County Treasurer \$261.82 collected from the sale of hogs at the stock yards. Receipt No. 21413. Same was ordered filed.

Motion by Commissioner Greer, seconded by Commissioner Morley, that the contract for the furnishing of materials and performing the work necessary to be done for the paving and otherwise improving of Memorial Boulevard from Admiral Place southwardly to East Eleventh Street, a distance of 0.89 mile, be awarded the Standard Paving Company in the amount of \$29,758.92, same being the low bid. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Greer, seconded by Commissioner Morley, that the Cash Fund Estimate of Needs and Request for Appropriation for the County Highway Cash Fund in the amount of \$14,246.08, be and the same is hereby approved and the Chairman is hereby instructed to sign same and submit it to the Excise Board for their consideration. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.
