McLelland and Gladys Raborn, be and they are hereby instructed to furnish bond in the amount of \$2,500 each, for handling state relief funds. All members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Hopkins, that the application for correction of erroneous assessment filed by A. L. Blakey covering Lot 4, Block 1, Gillette Hall Addition to the City of Tulsa, Tulsa County and personal property for the years 1931 and 1932, be and the same is hereby approved, and the County Clerk is hereby instructed to issue a certificate of error covering same. All members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner ~~Gray~~ Hopkins, that the Three affidavits of erroneous assessment filed by the Trustees for the Former Stockholders of the Tulsa Building & Loan Association of Record on July 10, 1935, covering real estate for the years 1930, 1931 and 1932, be and the same are hereby approved, and the County Clerk is hereby instructed to issue certificates of error covering same. All members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.
