J. B. Gray, Chairman presiding, the following business was transacted.

This being the day set for the opening of bids on the furnishing of materials and performing the work necessary to be done in the paving of Pine Street, West of Harvard Avenue to Sheridan Road, a distance of approximately 2.224 miles. The bids were as follows:

Motion by Commissioner Morley, seconded by Commissioner Greer, that said bids be referred to the County Engineer and Consulting Engineer for compilation. Said contract to be awarded Wednesday, April 29th, 1942. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.
