Tulsa, Okla. July 10th. 1922.

At a regular meeting of the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, held in the Court House of the City of Tulsa on the 10th. day of July, 1922, the following resolution was introduced by Commissioner Ira Short, who moved its adoption. The motion to adopt the resolution was seconded by Commissioner Geo.E.Gilmore, and the Chairman ordered the resolution read.

RESOLUTION.

WHEREAS, on the 19th. day of June, 1922, at a regular meeting of this Board an order was made directing the County Engineer to build a culvert between Sections 23 and 26, in Township 18, Range 12, East, in Jenks, Township, Tulsa County, Oklahoma, but inadvertently said order was not made of record although the County Engineer was duly instructed to perform the work and defray the costs thereof out of the appropriation of said Township for the Fiscal year 1921-1922.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Honorable County Clerk be and he is hereby instructed to correct the minutes of said meeting of June 19th. 1922, by incorporating this resolution therein.
