

R E S O L U T I O N .

BE IT RESOLVED: That it is deemed to be to the best interest of Tulsa County and there is hereby created as County Highway, the following described roads:

"Beginning at the corner of Section 35-36, Township 17, North, Range 12, East, on the Fourth Standard Parallel North, and running thence East to the Northeast Corner of Section 1, Township 16 North, Range 12 East; thence South Three Miles to the Tulsa-Okmulgee County Line;

Also, beginning at the corner of Section 7-12, 13 and 18, Township 16, North Range 12 and 13 East and running thence east Two Miles; thence North between Sections 8 and 9, 4 and 5, to the Township Line between Townships 16 and 17 North; thence East to the South Corner of Sections 32 and 33, Township 17 North, Range 13 East, thence North between Sections 32-33, 29-30 20 and 21, Township 17 North, Range 13 East to the Glenpool-Bixby County Highway.

Also, beginning at the Southwest Corner of Section 33, Township 17 North Range 13 East and running East along the Township line between Townships 16 and 17 North to the Northeast Corner of Section 2, Township 16, North Range 13 East, intersecting the Bixby-Okmulgee Road.

DRILLING CONTRACT.

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, Tulsa County, Oklahoma, Party of the first Part ~~xxx~~ E N Holmes, Party of the Second Part, known as the County Commissioners, Tulsa County Oklahoma, do hereby agree as follows: 1. The well to

Party of the first part, E N Holmes does hereby agree to drill said well the same to be located on the County Farm Tulsa County, Oklahoma, to a depth not to exceed Twenty One Hundred Feet (2100) or less than Nineteen Hundred and fifty (1950) known as the Wilcox Sand, or second break of Wilcox Sand or not to exceed 2200 feet.

Party of the first part agrees to drill this well to the above mentioned depth for a consideration of Two Dollars and seventy five cents (\$2.75) per foot.

It is further agreed by the party of the first part and the party of the second part that if this well should be dry at the above mentioned depth the party of the first part agrees to drill to any depth designated by the second party at a rate of Forty Dollars (\$40.00) per day. Said day to be a period of ten hours work.

In case this well should be dry the party of the first part agrees to pull all casing and plug said well at Forty Dollars (\$40.00) per day.

Party of the second part does hereby agree to furnish casing, fuel and water to the rig. Said casing shall be good heavy weight pipe acceptable to party of the first part.

In case of shut down due to lack of fuel, water or casing party of the second part does hereby agree to pay to the party of the first part Forty Dollars (\$40.00) per day for the period that the party of the first part is shut down. Weather conditions excepted.

In case said well should be a gas well party of the second part does hereby agree to furnish all tubing, packer and necessary equipment to complete the same. The party of the first part agrees to install the same at the rate of Forty Dollars (\$40.00) per day.

In case said well should be an oil well party of the second part does hereby agree to install all necessary equipment to obtain the production from said well. The party of the first part agrees to install the same at the rate of Forty (\$40.00) per day.

When a depth known as the Wilcox Sand, or second break, has been reached party of the second part assumes all responsibility of the hole and are responsible for all tools which are run in the hole after said depth has been reached. Party of the first part assumes the responsibility to this depth known as the Wilcox Sand.

The pulling of all pipe shall be done at the risk of the party of the second part.
