RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Andy Stokes, County Clerk of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, has made a report to this Board setting forth the result of the election held in Tulsa County on the 20th day of November, 1945 on the proposition of issuing the bonds of said Tulsa County in the amount of \$1,750,000.00 for the purpose of building and repairing bridges and constructing permanent state roads, and

WHEREAS we have carefully examined said report and find that there cast at said election, 11,763 votes, of which 9,425 votes were in favor of, 2,266 votes were against the issuance of said bonds and 72 votes were mutilated; now, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF TULSA COUNTY, STATE OF OKLAHOMA

THAT a lawful majority consisting of three fifths or more of the electors voting on said proposition cast their ballots in favor of the issuance of said bonds and the issuance thereof has been duly authorized.
