Depository Bond of First National Bank for \$100,000.00 was approved.

The Clerk was instructed to advertise for the sale of \$50,000.00 Bonds & to get them up in proper shape.

Clerk was instructed to advertise for bids on an addition to the Colored School, consisting of (4) four rooms - The Contractor to give Bond for the completion of work - Plans and Specifications are on file in the County Clerk's Office.
