Motion made and seconded to adopt the following Resolution

Whereas there has been notice duly served upon the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa Co. by the Clerk of said County, that there was on July 17-1911 a written Petition filed in his Office asking for the establishment and creation of a road improvement district in said County to be embraced in the territory in said Petition, It is therefore now ordered by the County Commissioners at this Special Meeting that Monday August 7-1911 be, and it is hereby fixed as a time for holding a meeting to hear and consider said Petition and any complaints or objections that may be made thereto and the County Clerk is hereby ordered and directed to publish in five successive issues of the Tulsa Daily Post, the time, place, purposes and object of said meeting.

Moved and seconded to adjourn to Aug 7-1911. Carried
