WHEREAS, there havine been filed with the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, report by the Board of Viewers, namely, W. A. Melton, Roy L. Sherrow and Willis M. Trotter, comprising the membership of a Board of Viewers appointed by xixid petition by J. N. Lane and others petitioning for the creation of a Levee and Drainage District for the Tulsa-Sand Springs area, dated October 7, 1940, the name of said proposed Levee and Drainage District designated TULSA-SAND SPRINGS LEVEE AND DRAINAGE DISTRICT -

The report of said Board of Viewers bearing date of January 14, 1941 recommends that said District, as proposed, be created and comprise the area confined within the boundaries as set out by description within the said report.
