Moved by Harris, seconded by Rice, to approve the Zoning Application from AG to RMH for 7 acres of the northwest corner of the tract, and the balance to RE. Mr. Compton asked that the applicant provide the legal description for the resolution. Board agreed. Upon roll call, Harris, yes; Rice, yes; Young, yes. Motion carried. (Clerks Misc.
