R E S O L U T I O N.

At a meeting of the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma,
in regular session on the 6th. day of November, 1924, the hereinafter resolution was introduced
by J S Shaver, Member of the Board, the same was duly read by the County Clerk, after which
motion was made by W L North, to adopt the resolution. The motion was seconded by JS Shaver,
and upon roll call the vote was as follows, to-wit:

The Resolution being as follows, to-wit:

WHEREAS, in the proposed improvements of the County Highway between Sections
1 and 12, Township 18 North, Range 14 East, effort having been made to obtain the extra right
of way required along the North Line of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ and the N $\frac{1}{2}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 12,
and it having been found impossible to obtain such extra-right of way amicably, and

WHEREAS, said right of way is necessary for the carrying out of said improve-
ment, and it is necessary that said lands herein described should, by virtue of the necessity
of the use of same as a permanent highway, be fully and completely owned by Tulsa County, State
of Oklahoma.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That this Board, acting for and on behalf of
Tulsa County, hereby direct the County Attorney of said County to institute in the Court of
proper jurisdiction, condemnation proceedings in said Court against Eva Bilby, et al, owners of
the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 12, Township 18 North, Range 14 East, for the condemnation and
appropriation for said purpose, of the following described lands:

Beginning at a point that is 24.75 feet South and 24.75 feet
East of the Northwest corner of said Section 12, and running
thence East and parallel to the North line of Section 12, a
distance of 1295.25, more or less, to the East line of the
Northwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of Section 12,
thence South 8.25 feet, thence West 1295.25 feet, more or
less, thence North 8.25 feet to the point of beginning and
containing 0.245 acres, more or less.

Said County Attorney is further directed to institute condemnation proceedings
in the Court of proper jurisdiction against E.V.Hartman and wife, owners of the N $\frac{1}{2}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$
of Section 12, Township 18 North, Range 14 East, for the appropriation and condemnation of the
following described lands:

Beginning at a point that is 24.25 feet South and 24.25 feet
West of the Northeast Corner of Section 12, Township 18 North,
Range 14 East, and running thence West and parallel to the
North Line of said Section 12, a distance of 2615.95 feet
more or less to the West line of the North Half of the North
East Quarter thence South 8.25 feet, thence East a distance
of 2615.95 feet more or less, thence North 8.25 feet to the
point of beginning and containing .49 acres, more or less.
