RESOLUTION FIXING THE 9th. DAY OF MAY, A D 1927 AS THE DATE OF HEARING OF COMPLAINTS AND OBJECTIONS TO THE APPRAISEMENT AND APPORTIONMENT OF BENEFITS TO WATER IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 5 TULSA COUNTY, OKLAHOMA, and PROVIDING FOR PUBLICATION OF NOTICE THEREOF, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, The Board of Appraisers heretofore duly appointed by this Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, in connection with the apportionment of benefits accruing to various lots, tracts and parcels of land in Water Improvement District No. 5, Tulsa County, Oklahoma, by reason of said Water Improvement District No 5 have filed their report and return of appraisal, and apportionment of benefits by the construction of the public distribution water system in said district; and

WHEREAS, it is the duty of the Board of County Commissioners to conduct a hearing of complaints and objections to said appraisal and apportionment and to give notice thereof and afford all persons interested an opportunity to be heard.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, By the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County Oklahoma, that a session of the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, be held at ten o'clock A.M., on the 9th. day of May A D 1927, at the County Commissioners Room in the County Court House in the City of Tulsa, Tulsa County, Oklahoma, for the purpose of hearing any and all complaints or objections that may be made by any person interested concerning the appraisal and apportionment of costs and benefits in Water Improvement District No. 5, Tulsa County, Oklahoma, and for the purpose of affording any and all persons that may be interested in said appraisal an opportunity to be fully and completely heard and to have their complaints or objections finally disposed of.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that notice of such hearing and session of the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, be given by the County Clerk of Tulsa County Oklahoma, by publication for two weeks in the Tulsa Tribune, a newspaper printed in Tulsa Tulsa County, Oklahoma, and of general circulation in Water Improvement District No. 5, and that such publication be made in the issues of the Tulsa Tribune of April 21st. April 28th and May 5th. 1927.

It being necessary for the preservation of the public welfare and safety that this resolution become operative and effective after its passage, it is hereby declared that same shall become operative from and after its passage and approval.
