A petition signed by property owners in and around the area of Bixby was presented to the Board of County Commissioners asking that the board open up, build and construct a new highway running in an easterly and westerly direction between Sections 12 and 13, Twp. 17, Range 13, Tulsa County. Motion by Commissioner Morley, seconded by Commissioner Gray, that the County Engineer be instructed to make a survey regarding said road and report back to the County Commissioners. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Morley, seconded by Commissioner Gray, that Roy L. Webb and E. D. Pope be appointed inspectors on the Road Projects at a salary of \$165.00 per month as of May 1st, 1942. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Greer, that the report filed by the Clerk of the Court of Common Pleas for the month of April, 1942, be and the same is hereby accepted and filed. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Greer, seconded by Commissioner Gray, that the following affidavits of erroneous assessment filed and approved by Dan A. Rowe, County Assessor, be and the same are hereby approved, to-wit:
