WHEREAS, the State Highway Commission of the State of Oklahoma has agreed to submit to the Secretary of Agriculture, a project for the improvement of 3.041 miles of Federal Aid Access highway from the SW corner of Section 23, T 20 N, R 13 E, thence East one mile, thence due south to U.S. Highway No. 75 a distance of 581.7 feet south of the NW corner of Section 1, T 19 N, R 13 E with funds apportioned to the State under the Federal Highway Act as amended and supplemented, and

WHEREAS, the County of Tulsa, Oklahoma, desires that such improvement be made and does agree to maintain said highway in a manner satisfactory to the State Highway Commission of the State of Oklahoma after its improvement, therefore:

BE IT RESOLVED: That the Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners of said County be, and he is hereby, authorized and empowered to enter into and execute a contract and agreement with said State Highway Commission carrying out the purposes of this resolution.
