\$1.00 for each additional patient in one household while on house call.

\$25.00 obstetrical care at time of delivery, whether in hospital or home.

Medical services to hospital patients whose hospitalization is paid for by the County, or who are eligible for out hospital services rendered at the hospital or in the County, NO CHARGE.

Cost of emergency drugs amounting to more than fifty cents  $(50\phi)$  per drug item furnished by the attending physician, being imperative to the extent that the patient would be seriously endangered if it was required for him to wait with the until the drug could be obtained from the County dispensary.

Medical and obstetrical services rendered and emergency drugs furnished during any part of the month after exhaustion of the \$800.00 per month aggregate allowance above referred to, NO CHARGE; (Except that any unexpended balance of the \$800.00 remaining in any month will go over into succeeding months for payment of fees and charges on the basis above provided. Over-expenditures will not be tolerated. Unavoidable delayed drug claims by designated dispensaries in any one month will be deducted from the allowance provided for succeeding months).

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED THAT DRUGS NEEDED by indigent patients served under this plan, upon prescription by their attending physician and certified to by the administrative head, shall be furnished such patients through the drug dispensary now provided by the County at 602 South Cheyenne, a record of drugs so furnished to be kept by the dispensary, and a monthly report thereof furnished this Board by the administrative head of this plan; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that drug dispensaries for use by patients in urgent emergencies be designated upon terms and conditions which may be hereinafter adopted.
