Tulsa, Okla., July 10th. 1922.

At a regular meeting of the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, held in the Court House in the City of Tulsa on the 10th. day of July, 1922, the following resolution was introduced by Commissioner Ira Short, who moved its adoption. The motion to adopt the resolution was seconded by Commissioner Geo. E. Gilmore, and the Chairman ordered the resolution read:

R E S O L U T I O N.

WHEREAS, on the 19th. day of June, 1922, at a regular meeting of this Board an order was made directing the County Engineer to build a culvert between Sections No. 23 and 26, in Township 18, Range 12 East, in Jenks Township, Tulsa County, Oklahoma, but inadvertently said order was not made of record although the County Engineer was duly instructed to perform the work and defray the costs thereof out of the appropriation of said Township for the Fiscal Year 1921-22.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Honorable County Clerk be and he is hereby instructed to correct the minutes of said meeting of June 19th. 1922 by incorporating this resolution therein.

The note on the motion to adopt the resolution was as follows:

The motion having received the majority of the votes cast was declared by the Chairman passed and ordered made a matter of record.

The following motion was presented by F.M. Wooden, who after reading the same moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Ira Short and upon roll call was unanimously carried.

Whereas, Tulsa County in cooperation with the State Department of Highways has financed and through a contract executed by and between the Department of Highways, and Keliher Construction Company, known as Contract No. 52, about completed said contract,

AND, WHEREAS, said contract beginning at the south corporate limits of Broken Arrow and extending south and east to the Wagoner County line, and

WHEREAS, said contract beginning at a point south of the present pavement in Broken Arrow will leave an unconnected section of the highway, and

WHEREAS, provision having been made in Section No. 1, of Chapter 42, Session Laws of 1921, whereby conditions similar to the above may be met by the County, and

WHEREAS, this Board believing that the property south of the main line of the M.K. & T Ry on the main street of Broken Arrow is not of sufficient value to be assessed and offer a marketable bond for the improvement thereof, by paying the said street, and that it
