

MONDAY, DECEMBER 17, 1984, CONTINUED

A Public Hearing was called to order at 11:27 a.m. for the purpose of discussing proposed amendments to the Major Street and Highway Plan by the following:

- a) deletion of the expressway classification for Riverside from the southeast corner of the Inner Dispersal Loop extending south along the east bank of the Arkansas River to the proposed Creek Expressway near 96th Street and South Delaware Avenue;
- b) adoption of new street and highway designations, titled Parkway, and Traffic-way Right-of-Way Standards for said Parkway designation; and
- c) designation of Riverside to a Parkway from approximately Denver Avenue and Riverside Drive south along the east bank of the Arkansas River to 131st St., then east along 131st St. to South Memorial Drive.

Steve Compton, INCOG, appeared and requested approval of the following as approved by the City Commissioners;

- a) the expressway classification be deleted for Riverside from I-44 South to 96th Street or proposed Creek Expressway;
- b) new designation of street and highway be adopted, titled Parkway as presented on Exhibit "A" attached to subject Resolution, deleting the word "minimum" as it relates to right-of-way for Parkway;
- c) the designation of Riverside Drive as Parkway be approved from I-44 South to 96th St. or proposed intersection with Creek Expressway.

The balance will return to the Planning Commission for continued public hearing on January 2, 1984. Rice asked if anyone was present to speak against the proposed amendments. There were none. Moved by Selph, seconded by Harris, to approve and authorize execution by Chairman, the above amendments as recommended by Mr. Compton and approved by the City of Tulsa. Upon roll call, Harris, yes; Selph, yes; Rice, yes. Motion carried.

Public Hearing closed at 11:32 a.m.

Andy Anderson, INCOG, appeared before the board and requested the board to cancel and disallow two party warrant #5181 in the amount of 7,350. issued to both Mrs. Bernadine Diffie and Golden Properties and issue one to Golden Property only. He stated that staff was satisfied that contractor has met all his obligations regarding this property with the exception of a leaking window, which will be repaired before warrant is released. Moved by Harris, seconded by Selph to cancel/disallow Warrant #5181 and issue new warrant subject to current problem being taken care of. Upon roll call, Harris, yes; Selph, yes; Rice, yes.
