Board of County Commissioners met in the County Clerk's office pursuant to adjournment. Present W. L. North and N. L. Sanders absent James Wooley.

In the matter of canvassing the returns of the Election Officers of the several voting Precincts in Road Improvement District No. One in Tulsa County Oklahoma, heretofore appointed, which votes were cast at the several Voting Places designated in said Road Improvement District No. one and advertised ten days before said date of election as required by law the County Commissioners having heretofore arranged with the duly appointed County Election Board to hold said election and conduct the same in cooperation with said County ^{Commissioners} ~~Election~~ Board. Proceeded to canvass the votes cast at said Election held in said Road Improvement District No. One on Tuesday September 19th 1911. In conjunction with said ^{Co} Election Board. Upon canvassing the votes it was ascertained and determined by said Board of County Commissioners, in session, that there were cast at said Election 1279 Votes

Number of Ballots "yes" 1018 Votes

Number of Ballots "No" 246 Votes

Number of Ballots spoiled and not counted 15 Votes

Whereupon it was found that more than three fifths of all votes cast at said election on the proposition to authorize the County Commissioners to issue bonds for and in behalf of said Road District No. one in the sum of \$500,000⁰⁰ were "yes" the
