RESOLUTION LEVYING ASSESSMENTS TO COVER COST OF
IMPROVEMENTS IN WATER IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 5,
TULSA COUNTY, OKLAHOMA.

WHEREAS, The Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, did appoint a time for holding a session to hear and consider any complaints or objections concerning the appraisal and apportionment of the costs of the construction of the public water distribution system in Water Improvement District No. 5, in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, and the proposed assessments therefor, and caused notice of such session to be published according to law, and in pursuance of such action and publication, such hearing has been had by the Board of County Commissioners of said County, on this 9th. day of May, A D 1927, and

WHEREAS, the said Board of County Commissioners has heard and considered any and all complaints and objections to said apportionment of costs, and has reviewed same and has approved same, as now of record and on file with the County Clerk of said County, there having been filed no complaints or objections thereto, and
