

Sept. 25th 1911.

The Board of County Commissioners met in regular session following previous adjournment. Members present James Woolley, W.L. North and M.L. Sanders.

The Commissioners proceeded to open and consider bids for the \$500,000.00 Bonds for Road Improvement Dist. No. 1, 3d for the \$166,000.00 County Road Bonds.

The following bids were received and filed, each accompanied by certified check for \$5000.00 - from -

A. J. McMahon	Oklahoma City.
Spitzer-Rorick & Co	Toledo, Ohio.
R. J. Edwards	Oklahoma City.
First Nat Bank	Tulsa.

After considering and comparing the several bids on motion the board took recess until 7 P.M.

Board re-convened at 7 O'clock P.M. and again considered bids for bonds. The bonds were then awarded to Spitzer-Rorick & Co., Toledo, Ohio, and the following resolution was adopted.

Resolution of Award -

Whereas Spitzer-Rorick & Co. of Toledo, Ohio are the highest and best bidders for the \$166,000.00 Tulsa Co. Road Bonds and the \$500,000.00 Road Dist. No. 1 Bonds both bearing 5% interest,

Now therefore be it resolved that said bonds be and same are hereby awarded to said Spitzer-Rorick & Co. and the County officials are hereby authorized and directed to execute and deliver said bonds to said Spitzer-Rorick & Co. on terms of their bid on file in the office of the County Clerk.

On Motion of W.L. North, seconded by James Woolley the above resolution was passed by the following vote.
