

THURSDAY, FEBRUARY 13th, 1941.

Pursuant to recess heretofore taken, the Board of County Commissioners reconvened at the hour of 10:00 o'clock A.M., with all members present: G. H. Shepard, Chairman; Ralsa F. Morley and Lincoln Sallee, members. Andy Stokes, County Clerk.

G. H. Shepard, Chairman presiding, the following business was transacted.

Motion by Commissioner Shepard, seconded by Commissioner Morley, that the application of the Board of County Commissioners and County Superintendent for additional and supplemental appropriations for the Dependent Separate Schools of said County in the amount of \$2,697.63, be and the same is hereby approved and ordered submitted to the Excise board for their consideration. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Upon motion made by Commissioner Sallee, seconded by Commissioner Morley, it was resolved that the Lease Contract for One Used Austin-Western No. 77 Senior, Dual Tandem Drive, 12 Ft. at a rental of \$275.00 per month, the period commencing on the 1st day of January and terminating on the 31st day of January, be renewed for a period of thirty (30) days commencing on the 1st day of February and terminating on the 28th day of February, which Lease Contract has heretofore been entered into between the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, and The Clarence L. Boyd Company, Inc., of Guthrie, Okla., and there being funds and cash on hand for this purpose available. Said Motion carried.
