RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, a portion of the East 5 acres of the West 30.5 acres of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 34, Twp. 19 N. Range 12 E., Tulsa County, Oklahoma, is needed by the County of Tulsa in connection with acquisition of right-of-way for the 51st Street Project; and

WHEREAS, said property can be acquired by amicable settlement from the owners, Wayne E. White and Laura Brown White, his wife, and from the United Federal Savings and Loan Association of Tulsa, for a consideration of \$1,900.00, which amount is deemed to be fair and reasonable;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the County purchase that part of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 34, Twp. 19 N. Range 12 E., Tulsa County, Oklahoma, more particularly described as follows, to wit:

Commencing at a point on the East line of the West 25.5 acres of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 34-19-12, said point being 273 Feet South of the North line of said Section 34-19-12, thence East along a line parallel to the North Line of said Section 34-19-12, to a point which is 313.5 feet West of the East Line of Said NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Section 34-19-12; thence South along said East line of said NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Section 34-19-12, a distance of 207 feet to a point; thence West along a line parallel to the North line of said Section 34-19-12, a distance of 23 feet to a point; thence West along a line parallel to the North line of said Section 34-19-12, to the east line of the West 25.5 acres of the said NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Section 34-19-12; thence North along the East line of said East line of the West 25.5 Acres of the said NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Section 34-19-12, a distance of 184 feet to the place of beginning,

paying therefor the sum of \$1,900.00, upon claim executed by said owners, and by the United Federal Savings and Loan Association of Tulsa, as its interest may appear.
