Upon roll call all members voting "AYE", the motion is declared carried.

In the matter of the appointment of County Physician to serve for a period beginning December 1st. 1924, and ending June 30th. 1925 the following bids were opened:

After carefully considering the bids, the award was made to Dr. L.C. Northrup at a monthly compensation of \$200.00, motion being made by W L North, seconded by J S Shaver, for the appointment of Dr. L.C. Northrup. Said appointment to be effective from and after December 1st. 1924. All members voting in the affirmative, the motion was declared carried.

R E S O L U T I O N .

WHEREAS, The State Highway Commission has advertised for Proposals for the construction of State Aid Project No. 67. And,

WHEREAS, State Aid Project No. 67, begins at the Tulsa-Pawnee County Line at the end of the Tulsa County Pavement, running thence through the town of Keystone crossing again into Tulsa County and thence to the Tulsa-Creek County Line, And

WHEREAS, the said Commission have made claim on Tulsa County for \$7,500.00 estimated to be 50% of the cost of grading, draining and paving with concrete, the portion of State Aid Project No. 67, that is located in Tulsa County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the Commissioners of Tulsa County approve the 9th. day of December 1924, the date set for letting of contracts for such improvement; and furthermore approve a 50% participation in cost of the improvement of that portion of State Aid Project No. 67, as located in Tulsa County, same to be graded, drained and paved with concrete pavement.

AND, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the said claim as above referred to be approved, but payment thereof be deferred until a sufficient collection accrues to the COUNTY HIGHWAY CASH FUND for 1924-25, to care for this and other existing obligations, at which time warrant will be drawn and forwarded to the State Highway Commission; same to be used with the understanding that the County participation shall not exceed 50% of the cost of Tulsa County portion of such Project No. 67.

AND, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That copy of this Resolution be furnished The State Highway Commission, and that they be asked to approve the same.
