Bassett who are three disinterested free holders from the body of the said Tulsa County and are not owners of any property to be assessed, are hereby appointed to commutate a Board of Appraisers to appraise and apportion the benefits received by the construction of said public distribution system to the several and parcels of land in said Water Improvement District, which said tracts, lots and parcels of land are described in schedule hereto attached and which said schedule is referred to and made a part of this resolution

That said appraisers shall, within five days after being notified of their appointment, after taking and subscribing their oath to make true and impartial appraisement and apportionment, proceed to perform all such acts and things in the premises as by law they are or will be required and empowered to do, and said appraisers shall make written report of such appraisement and apportionment to this Board of County Commissioners.
