RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Lots 18, 19, 20, 21, 22 and 23, Block 20, Amended Plat South Haven Addition, Tulsa County, Oklahoma, according to the Recorded Plat thereof, is needed by the County of Tulsa in connection with acquisition of right-of-way for the 51st Street Project; and

WHEREAS, said property can be acquired by amicable settlement from Willie Mae Taylor, Lacy Smith and Floyd Smith, owners of said property as the heirs at law of Mary Robinson, deceased, and from Willie Mae Taylor, the record owner of said property, and from Equitable Mortgage Company, mortgagee, of Tulsa, for a consideration of \$3,300.00, which sum is deemed to be fair and reasonable;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the County purchase Lots 18, 19, 20, 21, 22 and 23, Block 20, Amended Plat South Haven Addition, Tulsa County, Oklahoma, according to the Recorded Plat thereof, paying therefor the sum of \$3,300.00 to be paid upon claims executed by Willie Mae Taylor, in the amount of \$971.53, Lacy Smith, Floyd Smith and Waldo E. Jones, their attorney, in the amount of \$1,931.47; Fred Steiner (Equitable Mortgage Company), \$365.00, and \$32.00 to Tulsa County to reimburse the County for publication costs in Cases Nos. 82,672 and 82,915 District Court.
