Does Find ^{and} Declare.

1st. That the petition for incorporation presented to this board is signed by more than one-third of the qualified voters residing within the territory sought to be incorporated as such town of Kendall and such petition fully and correctly sets forth the boundaries of said proposed corporation; and the quantity of land therein and embraced thereby according to the survey and the resident population therein contained according to the census taken as provided by law and said petition has attached thereto affidavits verifying the facts alleged therein and said petition is now presented and heard in accord with the order and notice thereof heretofore made and the board further finds that the presentation and form and contents of said petition are in all things due, regular and in compliance with law.

2nd. The Board does further Find and Declare that the said incorporators, applicants for incorporators herein have caused an accurate survey and map to be made of the territory intended to be incorporated and embraced within the limits of said town and survey was made by a practical surveyor and does
