examination in the manner and for the period required by law and that all things required by law governing incorporation have been done and performed by said incorporators and petitioners herein and the board is fully satisfied that all of the requirements for the Act of the legislature governing cities, towns and villages and the incorporation of a town of the class of the proposed town of Kendall, have been fully complied with, it is therefore by the Board of County Commissioners, in due and regular session on this 7th. day of October, 1911.

Ordered, Adjudged and Decreed
The territory embraced in the proposed town of Kendall as shown by the plat thereof as filed herein by the incorporators and which plat was made by the said surveyor, and which plat is by reference made a part hereof, shall with the assent of the qualified voters thereof as provided and obtained at a meeting and election by said qualified voters, to be hereinafter held as provided by law be an incorporated town by the name of Kendall, Okla. a name which the board finds is a proper name for such town and is different from the names of every other town in the state of Oklahoma.

And the board does further order and require that a meeting and election of the qualified resident voters of such town be held at a convenient place therein, to wit at The Teel Store Building in Kendall, Okla. on the 23rd. day of October, 1911. and that an election on the matter of incorporating said
