O R D E R

NOW, On this the 28th. day of October, 1929, the matter of the Petition of Okla. Natural Gas Corporation for permission to lay a pipe line along, under and across certain highways in said County and State came up before the Board of County Commissioners of said County for hearing, and it appearing to the Baard and each of the Commissioners thereof that it was just that the said Oklahoma Natural Gas Corporation be permitted to use as much of the highways as designated by plat filed by said Corporation, and according to said description, which is as follows, to-wit:

2 Beginning at a point near the Southeast corner of the Northeast Quarter of Section Thirty Six (36), running thence North to a point within the North-east Q uarter of the Southeast Quarter of Section Twenty-Five (25), all in Township Twenty One (21) North, Range Thirteen (13) East, located within and along the West side of Section line road between Section Thirty One (31), Township Twenty-One (21) North, Range Fourteen (14) East, and Section ThirtynSix (36), Township Twenty One (21) North, Range Thirteen (13) East, and across the East and West Section line road between Sections Twenty Five and Thirty Six (36) Township Twenty-One (21) North, Range Thirteen (13), East a three (3) inch gas pipe line located according to blue print attached hereto and made a part hereof; known as Line J W (E Parris #1) C A & D.
