O R D E R

There coming on for hearing before the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, said Board being in regular session, on this the 14th day of November, 1949, the application of The Board of Education of the City of Tulsa of the State of Oklahoma for an order whereby the said applicant will be absolved and freed of any and all liability for all taxes previously assessed for the year 1947 against the following described property, to-wit:

Tract 1.

South 264 feet of the Northwest Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of the Southeast Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of the Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Twenty-seven (27), Township Twenty (20) North, Range Thirteen (13) East, of the Indian Base and Meridian, being more particularly described as follows, to-wit: Beginning at the Southwest corner of the Northwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of said Section twenty-seven (27), thence East a distance of Six Hundred Sixty (660)feet; thence North a distance of Two hundred Sixty-four (264) feet; thence West a distance of Six Hundred Sixty (660) feet; thence South a distance of two hundred sixty-four (264) feet to the point of beginning, in Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, according to the Government Survey thereof;
