

July 7th, 1919.

The Board of County Commissioners of the County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, met in a regular session in the Commissioners' Room of the Tulsa County Court House on the 7th day of July, 1919, at nine (9) oclock A. M. Present:- C. E. Suppes, Chairman, W. L. North, Vice Chairman, and R. A Martin Member, constituting the Old Board of County Commissioners and F. M. Wooden and Ed Dalton the newly elected members, W. L. North having been re-elected, and Lewis Cline, ex-officio Secretary of the Board.

On motion made by W. L. North and seconded by R. A. Martin, the old board of County Commissioners adjourned Sine Die, and surrendered their chairs to the new Board of County Commissioners whose bonds were approved by W. B. Williams, County Judge.

The bonds of the new commissioners having been approved, and the members having been sworn in, the proceddof organization was then taken up, the first business before the new board being the election of a temporary Chairman.

A motion was made by W. L. North and seconded by F. M. Wooden that Ed Dalton act as temporary Chairman. Said motion carrying.

Thereupon the meeting proceeded, and a motion was made by W. L. North and seconded by Ed. Dalton that F. M. Wooden be elected permanent Chairman. Said moti n being voted upon and by the Chairman of the Board declared unanimously carried.

Ed Dalton, temproary chairman, then surrendered his chair to F. M. Wooden, the duly elected chairman of the Board of County Commissioners for the pursuant term, and themecting proceeded in general order.

On motion duly made and seconded W. L. North was elected vice Chairman of the Board of County Commssioners.

The auditing and allowing of the claims, both general and township was then taken up, after which the usual routine of business,
