AND, it further appearing from the petition herein that said pipe line will be constructed under the rules and regulations and supervision of the City Water Department of the City of Tulsa, and will be co constructed as not to interfere with any of the rights of the general public in the use of said highways and also will be constructed in accordance with all rules and regulations of the County Commissioners and the laws of the State of Oklahoma governing same.

It is hereby ordered and adjudged by the Board of County Commissioners of said County that permission be granted and the same is hereby granted to said George S. Bole, Chas. T. Abbott and Forrest C. Welch, their heirs and assigns, to use as much of the highway as above designated for the purpose of constructing said water line.
