R E S O L U T I O N

WHEREAS, for the purpose of constructing a County Highway through and across certain land in Section Twenty Four (24), Township Eighteen (18), North, Range Twelve (12) East, it is necessary to acquire a strip of land particularly described as follows:

A Strip of land for highway purposes in the NE¹/₄ of Section 24, T 18 N., R 12 E., described as follows: Beginning at the SW corner of said NE¹/₄ of Sec. 24, thence in a northerly direction along the North and South Center line of Sec. 24, 83 feet to a point; thence N 89°-39' E parallel to the east and west center line of Sec. 24, 744 feet to a point; thence S 60°-21' East, 166 feet to the intersection with the East and West center line of Section 24, thence S 89°-39' W. along said East and West center line of Section, 888 feet to point of beginning, containing 1.55 acres, more or less".

AND, WHEREAS, Tulsa County has been unable to affect an amicable settlement in the matter of the said strip of land owned by MARY A FRAILEY AND E L FRAILEY, her husband

AND, WHEREAS, it is necessary to acquire said strip of land for right of way purposes by condemnation proceedings,

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the County Attorney, in the name of this Board for and on behalf thereof, be and he is hereby instructed to institute condemnation proceedings in the District Court of This County for the purpose of condemning said above described tract of land for County Highway purposes.

AND, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this resolution is an amendment to a resolution passed by this Board on March 19th. 1928, condemning land for highway purposes from Mary A Frailey and E L Frailey, her husband.
