RESOLUTION

Now, on this 26th day of November, 1951, there comes on for hearing before the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, the petition of resident freeholders of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, which petition prays for the vacation and setting aside of the dedication of a road effected by a quit claim deed from Ollie M. Brewer and Julia A. Brewer, husband and wife, to the public, dated October 5, 1950, filed in the office of the County Clerk of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, October 24, 1950, and recorded in Book 2145, page 405, insofar as the same covers the following-described property, to-wit:

The East 25 feet of the South 140 feet of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 35, Township 20 North, Range 13 East, Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma,

and for good cause shown, the hearing is continued until the 28th day of November, 1951, at 10:00 A.M.;

And now on this 28th day of November, 1951, this matter comes on for hearing before the said Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, and it appearing that said petition is in all respects sufficient, and that due notice thereof has been given by publication in the Tulsa Daily Legal News, as shown by an Affidavit of Publication on file herein, and by Notice to Owners given at least six days prior to this hearing, and it further appearing that said land has never been used by the public as a road or highway, and that a road thereon is unnecessary and impractical;

Be it hereby resolved by the County Commissioners of the County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, sitting in regular session, that the road over and across the above-described property is hereby vacated, abandoned, and the conveyance thereof to the public is hereby set aside, and this board hereby finds and determines that there is no public necessity for the existence of the road thereon,
