#### R E S O L U T I O N.

WHEREAS, School Districts numbered Nineteen (19) and Joint One (J1) have filed with this Board audits of the Tax Rolls of Tulsa County for the years 1909 to 1923, inclusive, alleging that by reason of errors there is due to the said Municipalities certain sums of money.
