Motion made by Commissioner Greer, seconded by Commissioner Bailey, that the resignations of Fred Medlin, Forrest Castle and E. H. King, Deputies in the Sheriff's office, effective December 31, 1945, be and the same are hereby accepted. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Greer, seconded by Commissioner Gray, that the resignation of W. Emil Sims, Constable in District #10, as of December 17, 1945, be and the same is hereby accepted. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Greer, seconded by Commissioner Gray, that the bond filed by W. Emil Sims, Constable District #10, and made by the Western Surety Company in the amount of \$1,000 be and the same is hereby cancelled. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Mr. Gray, Chairman: I would like to make a motion that we give to the American War Moms the use of one of the NYA Barracks located at the Fair Grounds, free of rent, for one year to be used by them in establishing a factory for the employment of disabled veterans who are returning from service and will need some kind of a work project. Many of these veterans will be entirely disabled and unable to find employment or to hold jobs elsewhere.

Mr. Greer: I second that motion providing it meets with the approval of the Fair Board.

Mr. Bailey: I also second that motion providing it is agreeable with the Fair Board.

Chairman declared motion carried as made and seconded.

Motion made by Commissioner Greer, that all NYA Buildings located at the Fair Grounds be turned over to the Fair Board. Motion died for want of a second.

Motion made by Commissioner Greer, seconded by Commissioner Bailey, that the appointment of Charles Byrley, as Deputy Sheriff at a salary of \$175.00 per month, effective as of today - January 7, 1946, be and the same is hereby approved. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Greer, that a recess be taken until 2:00 o'clock P. M. Motion carried.
