

"Know all Men by these Presents: That the undersigned John C. Greenstreet and Wilma A. Greenstreet, husband and wife, being the owners of all lots and blocks in Coleman Addition to the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, included and embraced in the plot and dedication of said addition filed in the office of the County Clerk of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, in plot Record No. 1443 on January 22nd, 1949, do hereby revoke, cancel, annul and forever vacate said plat and dedication in its entirety, except all streets and avenues and all easements dedicated for the purpose of installing and maintaining public utilities."
