Gentlemen: --We beg to report to you that on the 26th and 27th of June, we made an' investigation of the roads being constructed in and near Joplin Missouri, where it is known to us that concrete roads are being constructed with crushed filnt stone, Joplin Chats, Sludeg and cement. The Joplin Chats being used as a filler in the crushed flint stone, which crushed flint stone is in size from about 3/4" to 12" inches, xwkkekxwkkkxkexkexkexkkakkexwkkkxkkexxxffkekakxkezkex This road construction is federal. State and County participation. Due to the trouble we have been having with too much dirt, shale and clay in the finer stone, we have been using as a filler the larger sized stone, prompted this investigation, and we recommend to you that you grant us permission allowing us to use Joplin Chats, properly porportioned with the native crushed lime stome, which will be in accordance withthe official tests which we will conduct before allowing the use of same. We are convinced that this will be a wise policy, and ask your permission to use the same under such restrictions as we may determine after having constructed the test we will subject the material to.
