The meeting was called to order by the Chairman, after which the meeting proceeded in general order.

A motion was made by W. L. North and seconded by Ed Dalton that Joe Duncan be appointed Road Overseer of West Wekhwa Township, begining at Sand Springs, Oklahoma, and extending westward. Said motion being voted upon and duly carried.

A motion was made by W. L. North and seconded by Ed Dalton that the Chamber of Commerce of the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, be appointed to serve in the same capacity.

A motion was made by W. L. North and seconded by Ed Dalton that T. C. Hughes be reappointed consulting engineer of the County of Tulsa, Oklahoma, to serve at the preasure of the foard, at the same salary as previously paid, \$250.00 per month. said motion being duly voted upon and by the hairman declared unamimously carried.

A motion was made by W. L. North and seconded by Ed Dalton that Dan W. Patton be reappointed County Engineer to serve in the same capacity and at the same salary as previously paid, \$250.00 per month. Said motion being boted upon and by the Chairman of the Board declared unanimously carried.

A motion was made by W. L. North and seconded by Ed Dalton that the plans for the Bridge over Caney River be approved as submitted by Dan W. Patton, County Engineer. Whereupon said motion was voted upon and declared unanimously carried.

A motion was made by W. L. North and seconded by Ed Dalton that the State Examiner and Inspector be instructed to complete the work now partially completed, and report immediately to the Foard of County Commissioners. Whereupon said motion was voted upon, and the Chairman declared the same unanimously carried.

A motion was made by W. L. North and seconded by Ed Dalton that the assessment against Lots 11, 12, 13, and 14 in Block 3, Friend Gillette AddPtion to the City, of Tulsa, Oklahoma, for the year of 1919, be and the same was therebe cancelled on account of said property being in the possession of the first Methodist Episcopal Church of the City of Tulsa, Okkahoma.

Moved by Commissioner W. L. North and seconded by Ed Dalton that Lewis Cline, County Clerk, be authorized to advertise for bids for the County Printing for a term of one year. Said Bids to be received on July 21st, 1919. Said motions being voted upon and unanimously carried.

Uopn motion of Commissioner W. L. North, which motion was seconded by Ed Dalton, to the effect that the Countý Engineer be instructed to extend the work under the contract of the Big Four Bewing Company, so as to pave and otherwise inprove the road from the intersection of College Avenue with the North Line of Section 8, Township 19 North, Range 13 East, east along said section line to the begining of the Big Four Company's original contract, begining at the Northeast corner of section 8, payment to be made at the same unit prices as in the original contract set out, and in the manner therein set forth, other wise the said motion to be placed in effect.
