A motion was made by W. L. North and seconded by Ed Dalton that H. B. Haddock be appointed Road Overseer for the West One Half of Skiatook Township. Said motion carrying.

On motion duly made and seconded Ed Cason was duly appointed Road Supervisor for the East half of Skiatook Township.

A motion was made by W. L. North and seconded by Ed Dalton that W. G. Ogan be appointed Road Supervisor for the East one half of Owasso Township, and Ira Butts for the west one Half of Owasso Township, said motion being voted upon and unanimously carried.

A motion was made by W. L. North and seconded by Ed Dalton that W. R. Martin be appointed Road Supervisor for the North one half of Glennpool Township and W. S. Moore for the South one half of Glennpool township, all funds to be divided equally. Whereupon said motion was voted upon and by the Chairman declared duly carried.

A motion was made by W. L. North and seconded by Ed Dalton that Joe Gaddy be appointed Road Supervisor for six sections along the south side of Boles Township and Willow Springs Township. Said motion being voted upon and declared carried.

A motion was made by W. L. North and seconded by Ed Dalton that Walter Goodman be appointed township road supervisor of the North five miles of Boles Township. said Motion being voted upon and by the Chairman of the Board declared duly carried.

A motion was made by W. L. North and seconded by Ed Dalton that the minutes of the ~~xxx~~ Special Meeting of the Board of Education of the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, showing the proceedings of the election held on the 16th day of May, 1917, for excess levy be accepted and filed by the County Clerk. Whereupon said motion was voted upon, all members voting "yes".

A motion was made by W. L. North and seconded by Ed Dalton that H. B. Sanders be appointed Tax Ferret for Tulsa County for a term of two years. See Contract File No. 9354, assigned May 13, 1920 to W. M. Gullager.
