Motion by Commissioner Morley, seconded by Commissioner Greer, that the proposal, plans and specifications for the furnishing of materials and performing the work necessary to be done for the grading and drainage of Memorial Boulevard from 11th Street (U.S. Highway 66) to 51st Street (U.S. Highway 64), a distance of 4.08 miles at an estimated cost of \$14,172.28, be and the same are hereby approved and the County Clerk is hereby instructed to advertise for bids to be received until 9 o'clock A.M., June 22nd, 1942, said advertisement to be given to the Newspaper Printing Corporation and to run for two consecutive weeks.
