

R E S O L U T I O N

WHEREAS, Tulsa County is the owner of a tract of real estate deeded to it by Sheriff's Deed, said property being located in Tulsa County, State Of Oklahoma, and described as follows, to-wit:

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That it is for the best interests of said County and it is therefore ordered that the hereinabove described real estate be sold and conveyed in manner and form as provided by law for the sale of real estate of the County so deeded to and held by the County; that said tract of land be appraised and offered for sale as provided by law, and that the County Clerk is hereby directed to certify copy of this Resolution to the Judge of the District Court of said Tulsa County with the petition and prayer that said Judge determine whether such sale is for the best interest of said County and order and direct this Board to sell said real estate as above provided and resolved and as provided by law, and that the Judge of said District Court appoint three resident freeholders of said County to appraise said real estate accordingly and make report of said appraisement to this Board, all as provided by law.
