IN RE: Application of Oklahoma Natural Gas Company, a Corporation of Tulsa Oklahoma, to construct pipe lines over, under along and across the public highways of Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

Entering the north and south section line highway known as North Cincinnati Avenue, between Sections 23 and 24, Township 20, North, Range 12, East, at the southeast Corner of said Section 23, thence south along the west side of North Cincinnati Avenue to the intersection of North Cincinnati Avenue with Pine Street, thence west along the south side of Pine Street to the Osage-Tulsa County line at the northwest corner of Lot 5
