RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, a portion of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 35, Township 19 North, Range 12 East of the Indian Base and Meridian, Tulsa County, Oklahoma, is deeded by the County of Tulsa in connection with the acquisition of right-of-way for the 51st Street Project; and

WHEREAS, said property can be acquired by amicable settlement from the owners, James L. Radford and Corrine Marie Radford, husband and wife, and from Federal National Mortgage Association, a Corporation of Dallas, Texas, for a consideration of \$125.00, which amount is deemed to be fair and reasonable.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the County purchase a portion of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 35, Township 19 North, Range 12 East, of the Indian Base and Meridian, Tulsa County, Oklahoma, more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

Commencing at a point 731 feet West and 265 feet South of the NE corner of said NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of said Section 35-19N-12E; thence South and parallel to the North and South Center Line of said Section 35-19N-12E, a distance of 35 feet to a point; thence West and Parallel to the North Line of said Section 35-19-12E, a distance of 100 feet to a point; thence North along a line parallel to the said North and South Center Line of said Section 35-19N-12E, a distance of 20 feet to a point; thence East along a line parallel to the said North Line of said Section 35-19N-12E, a distance of 7.52 feet to a point; thence North along a line parallel to the said North and South Center Line of said Section 35-19N-12E, a distance of 15 feet to a point, said point being 265 feet South and 823.48 feet West of the said NE corner of the said NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of said Section 35-19N-12E; thence East along a line parallel to the North Line of said Section 35-19N-12E, a distance of 92.48 feet to the place of beginning.

paying therefor the sum of \$125.00 upon claim executed by the said owners, and by the Federal National Mortgage Association, a Corporation of Dallas, Texas, as its interest may appear, and that the County pay said James L. Radford and Corrine Marie Radford \$475.00 to reimburse them the cost of relocating poultry and brooder house.
